Schedule Mandatory captains' meeting Thursday, December 8th , 2016, at 7 p.m. at the Padre Island Yacht Club, 13403 Whitecap Blvd. Parade positions, call signs, parade route, communications and safety procedures will be covered.
Friday, December 9, 2016, Galleon Bay/Commodores Cove parade. Marshalling will be at 6:30 p.m. Parade will start at 7 p.m.
Saturday, December 10, 2016, north and south sides of Whitecap Blvd parade. Marshalling will be at 5:30 p.m. at the Caravel boat ramp north of Whitecap Blvd. Parade will start at 6 p.m.
Sunday, December 11, 2016, at 9 a.m. at the Padre Island Yacht Club, collected toys will be given to the US Marines for their Toys for Tots® campaign. Awards ceremony and brunch will follow at 10 a.m.

Information Awards will be given for first place in the following categories:

Sailboat: 3 Categories, less than 20', 20' – 30', 31' and greater

Power Boat: 3 Categories, less than 20', 20-30 and 31' and greater

Best of Fleet: Top boat across all categories

All boats must have current registration and insurance.
Working VHF radios are required aboard all vessels
All vessels must meet US Coast Guard safety requirements.
Only engine power can be used during the parade.

Parade registration will not be accepted after the captains' meeting.
This is the 20th year we will be collecting Toys for Tots® during the La Posada Boat Parade. Toys must be new and in original packaging. Have a party, have attendees bring a toy and we will pick up the toys at your dock during the parade. Simply flash a white light at our collector boats showing yellow flashing lights and we will get to you. Be patient; it will be both busy and dark.
